

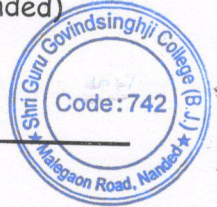

- 5. Capacity Building:** Through skill development programs, training sessions, and career counseling, the ST Cell aims to enhance the employability and

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
entrepreneurial skills of ST students, empowering them to become self-reliant and contribute meaningfully to society.
