Session Highlights: Prof. Ragade Jwala R. began the session by introducing the concept of the Human Development Index (HDI). She explained that HDI is a composite index that measures a country's average achievements in three basic aspects of human development: health, education, and standard of living. These dimensions are represented by:

- 1. Life Expectancy: A measure of the overall health and longevity of a population.
- Education Index: Assessed through mean years of schooling and expected years of schooling.
- Gross National Income (GNI) per Capita: Reflecting the standard of living and income levels.

Prof. Jwala elaborated on the origins and development of the HDI, detailing how it was introduced by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in 1990 as a way to shift the focus from purely economic measures of development, such as GDP, to a broader understanding of human well-being.

Key topics covered during the session included:

1. Calculation and Interpretation of HDI:

- The methodology used to calculate HDI and its components.
- How to interpret HDI scores and rankings to understand a country's development status.

2. Strengths and Limitations of HDI:

- The advantages of using HDI as a measure of development, including its simplicity and focus on human well-being.
- Criticisms and limitations of HDI, such as its inability to capture inequality, environmental sustainability, and cultural factors.
