Autumn." He explored the recurring themes in Keats' poetry, such as the transient nature of beauty, the interplay between reality and imagination, and the inevitability of death. Prof. Reddy also discussed Keats' unique poetic style, characterized by rich imagery, sensuous language, and profound emotional depth.

One of the key points of Prof. Reddy's lecture was the concept of "Negative Capability," a term coined by Keats himself, which refers to the poet's ability to embrace uncertainty and doubt without the need for rational explanation. Prof. Reddy elaborated on how this concept is reflected in Keats' work and how it has influenced subsequent generations of poets and writers.

The session was highly interactive, with participants engaging in a lively discussion following the lecture. They asked questions about the interpretation of specific poems, Keats' influence on modern poetry, and the personal challenges he faced as a poet. Prof. Reddy responded with detailed explanations, enriching the participants' understanding of Keats' literary contributions.
